VINIFICATION

Hand harvested, selected on the sorting table, destalked, lightly crushed, cooled, blended, pumped in large steel tanks, barreled for malolactic fermentation.



VARIETALS

65% Grenache,
15% Mourvèdre
15% Syrah,
5% Muscardin.



BARREL

Oak.



RESIDUAL SUGAR

1 gram per liter.



MATURATION

9-14 months in the barrel and in vats.



ACIDITY

2 grams per liter.
